COSTUMING/TIGHTS

ALL dancers require proper costuming, TIGHTS,
hairstyles as set by class and footwear.

NO dancer will be permitted on stage at any competition or recital
without proper costuming, tights & footwear.

(Walmart tights are not the same and all dancers need to purchase the
correct tights as outlined by class.)

Costuming & Tights are now beginning to arrive, and they will be sent home in your dancer's class over the next few weeks.

Please do not attempt to iron your costumes, as they may melt or deform. To release the wrinkles steam only! (If the costume gets dirty hand-wash and hang to dry or dry-clean. (Dry cleaning pertains to certain costumes only).

If you did not order tights and are unsure of the hair requirements for your dancer's class, please see the bulletin board in the studio lobby. Tights can be purchased from Murray at Audition Dance Supply, or one of the other dancewear stores.

**PLEASE NOTE:

All costumes are ordered to the measurements of your dancer, and are not custom sewn. Therefore alterations are the responsibility of each person. If you wish to hire a seamstress to do them for you here is a list of available seamstresses. You may also use stitches/superstore/jeans & things or any other alteration business.

- * Some costumes may also require straps to be sewn down...please do not pin these, they need to be securely fastened.
- *ALL dancers need to look uniformed and alike for competition so please ensure that you are aware of the tights needed for each particular dance and the hairstyle that is required and adhere to the description.
- *NO Jewelry...including ALL earrings, nail polish or tattoos allowed for any performances.
- *NO PANTIES under the dance costumes, as ALL tights come with a built in panty!!
