

# Dance Dimensions Student/Parent Handbook 2018-2019

*Welcome to Dance Dimensions for all new and returning students and parents! This guide should answer all your questions, as well as give you a year to date calendar of events and deadlines at the studio...*

## ***Dancers/Parents***

We have a 30 cubby wall system for dancers to use for their jackets, small dance bags etc. We encourage our dancers to utilize this space for storage! We also have a 10 compartment cell phone/wallet locker. Dancers need to bring their own lock for these lockers and we ask that they please share with friends, as there are only 10 of them. We are **NOT** responsible for items left in the lobby if they are not locked up.

**Dancers are NOT allowed to bring any items into the dance rooms, so please only bring what is necessary to the studio. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave items over night!**

We understand that the lobby gets extremely busy here and finding space is never easy, but we ask you to do your best to be out of traffic ways when getting your children ready for class; if the doorways are clear, people are able to get in and out more easily and hopefully the lobby won't be so crowded. If your dancer has excess clothing (pants, jackets, sweaters, etc.) please hang them on the hooks on the wall or place them in a cubby box.

Please do not feel obligated to stay and wait while your dancer is in class. Feel free to use this time to do some running around. Our lobby area is very small and with dancers waiting in between classes it can get quite full. We also ask that parents drop off their dancers no more than 15 minutes prior to their class time and pick them up on time.

We encourage parents to leave the studio during your child's 45 minute class (consider it time to run errands or grab a quick coffee) as the lobby does get SO packed. Please ensure that the office has your home phone number as well as a cell number available in case there is any reason we need to get ahold of you.

We ask that parents refrain from entering the dance studios at anytime, with the exception of the scheduled watch week. We run on a very tight time frame and cannot afford to give up class time. If you have any questions for your teachers please EMAIL the studio and Amanda will pass the message onto the teacher and she will get back to you as soon as she can.

\*We hold one watch week in the dance season, see the calendar for details. We ask that you limit the number of people who attend watch week as the studio space is limited, thank you.

### ***Costuming 2018/2019***

There is a costume deposit of \$75 due for each class your dancer is registered in. This payment is due **Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup>**.

The total costs for costuming is \$80-\$120 for younger less competitive classes and \$100-\$160 for older more competitive classes. Final charges for costuming is due **Saturday November 17<sup>th</sup>**.

### ***Hair/Dancewear/Footwear***

A complete list of requirements for all classes is available on our website. We will strictly enforcing them this season, so be sure your dancer has their hair properly secured every class, and wears the correct attire and footwear. If a dancer repeatedly has their hair down or is not dressed appropriately for class they will not be permitted to take part. A hockey player cannot participate without skates... therefore a dancer needs to also be prepared for every class :)

### ***Class Attendance***

Dance Dimensions is a competition performance studio therefore regular class attendance is expected. If a dancer needs to miss a class we appreciate an email to [dancedimensions@sasktel.net](mailto:dancedimensions@sasktel.net) to inform the studio.

In the event of a dancer missing multiple classes and therefore falling behind in the classes & choreography he / she may be removed from a section of choreography. We do not offer private lessons to catch dancers up. Please remember that our classes go until the end of May and attendance AFTER the competitions is still very important!

### ***Dance Dimensions Studio Merchandise***

DD studio merchandise is only ordered once per season. We offer some DD clothing such as sweatpants, hoodies, track suits, gym bags, etc.

The date of the DD order is **Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>**.

### ***Solo, Duo, Trio (Private Lessons)***

Students interested in learning a solo/duo/trio for the competition season may pick up forms in the office or on the bulletin board.

**Deadline to register is October 1st!!!**

Dancers may participate in 2 competitions as well as our Solo/Duo/Trio Recital on March 10th at the Regina Performing Arts Center. Costuming for these routines can be ordered from our supplies (see your teacher and we will let you look through the books and price costumes out for you!) or you may borrow/rent one from a previous dance year. Discuss your costume with your teacher as they need to approve it BEFORE stage.

\*All students interested in participating are expected to practice outside of the allotted studio time and remember the choreography given to them by their teacher. This is a big commitment for both dancers and teachers so please talk directly to your teacher for more information! (More specific information including the cost is on the Entry form for Solos/Dups/Trios.)

## ***General Competition, Rehearsal & Recital Information***

All classes and dancers participate in 1-2 competition performances held in late March/early April. See the calendar of Events for the exact dates.

**Our tiny tot classes perform at our annual Solo/Duo/Trio Spring Showcase, they do NOT attend any competitions.**

Our Combo classes as well as our Acro classes only attend the Showcase competition in Regina, NOT the Spring Stars competition in March.

ALL full season classes (Sept-May) participate in the year-end recital. Our recital is held at the Conexus Arts Center & we will hold two shows. One Monday May 27th (Tiny Tot, Pre-Primary, Primary & Junior Classes) and the other on Tuesday May 28th (Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate & Senior classes ~ including all Showstopper classes).

**\*Each show will have its' own rehearsal during the day of the show.**

\*Please remember that we are a competition performance studio and it is imperative that all dancers attend the competitions and performances. Dance is a team sport but we do not have any "substitutes" when a dancer is missing.

\*Regular class attendance is expected for all dancers, in the event of an absence we ask that you email the studio. Thank you for your cooperation!

**DD believes the experience of performing before a live audience helps each dancer develop self confidence and stage personality.**

## ***DD Policies & Regulations***

- ~All classes are paid over a 9 month regardless of how many classes are held in that month. Monthly fees are not pro-rated based on the number of classes/month. The monthly tuition is equally spread over 9 months.
- ~ Any accounts outstanding past 60 days will result in withdrawal of services.
- ~ Regular class attendance is expected for all ages/levels... we are a TEAM sport and missed dancers on a regular basis has an effect on everyone in the class.
- ~ A one month written notice to the office is required to withdraw from any class.
- ~ Teachers are NOT responsible for dancers during their class breaks, as we are in class teaching. Parents please note that your children are UNSUPERVISED in the lobby area and we ask that you remind them to CLEAN UP after snacks and break times.
- ~ **Please ensure that your dancers are NOT snacking in-between classes** on “sugar straws”, slurpees or candy. It is very difficult to fully participate in an active class when they are on a “sugar high”. It is also very difficult for the teachers!
- ~ **We have also BANNED POPCORN & SLURPEES from the studio!** All too often they create a big mess and also many spills. Please choose snacks for your dancer that are healthy and provide energy.
- ~ We also ask that the table area be for the dancers only. Many of them have multiple classes and use this area for lunches/suppers and doing homework.

*Absolutely no nut products allowed in the studio at any time.*

*We are a NUT FREE ZONE, due to severe allergies!*

***ALL MONTHLY FEES ARE DUE ON OR BEFORE THE 1ST OF EACH MONTH.***

Please see Jayme in the office during this time for all payments. You may use the lock box, located outside of the office when the office closed.

**A 2% INTEREST CHARGE WILL BE APPLIED TO ACCOUNTS OVER 30 DAYS!!**

*(Any accounts over 60 days will result in suspension of services)*

**The preferred method of payment is a pre-authorized credit card.**  
Payments are also accepted by cash, money order, direct payment, Visa or MasterCard.  
We do not accept CHEQUES!
