Classes after competition

Showstoppers $-2019 \sim 2020$

We will be hosting our auditions for the Showstoppers on Wednesday May 29th in the evening. Details on the time, expectations and regulations of a troupe member will be posted on the bulletin board by Studio A in May. (Some are listed below).

We will be taking a new Pre-Intermediate group this season. Dancers must be 10-12 years as of September 2019 and have a minimum of two years Jazz/Tap/Ballet training. Please discuss with Kara before having your dancer audition as some 10 year olds may be ready for the Showstoppers while others may not.

I will be hosting a "new parent" troupe meeting for those interested but would like more details on Thursday May 2nd in the studio lobby at 6:30 pm.

- *Members must be enrolled in a Ballet class, Ballet technique class and in a Ballet exam class. All dancers must also be in conditioning.
- *Intermediates & Senior dancers have the option of taking a Lyrical class.
- *A commitment to Showstoppers means that **ALL** other activities fall in line behind dance if there should be a conflict of schedules. THIS INCLUDES DANCE TEAMS and all other sports!
- *Only 100% commitment will be accepted from ALL!

Rehearsal & Recital Information

Rehearsal – May 27th (Beginning as early as 9:30/10:00 am)

Our rehearsal is held at the Conexus Arts Center, and a schedule will be available on our website during Easter break or just before.

*This is an all day rehearsal with the show that evening starting at 6:30 pm for our tiny tot, combo, pre-primary, primary & junior dancers. (This also includes the adult classes & the Showstoppers).

It is VERY IMPORTANT for ALL dancers to be at Rehearsal, so during the show they know where they are supposed to be.

Rehearsal – May 28th (beginning at 9:30 am)

Held at the Conexus Arts Center – schedule to be available on the website during or before Easter break.

*This is an all day rehearsal with the show starting at 6:30 pm for our Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate & Senior dancers. (This includes all Showstoppers & adult classes).
