***ALL Waivers must be tuned into the studio by now, deadline was Sept. 24th.**

ALL dancers need PROPER DANCEWEAR FOR ALL CLASSES!

Visit the website for the dancewear requirements. All dancers also must wear their hair in ponytail/pigtails/braids for classes – Ballet class MUST be a bun. We will NOT permit any dancers into the classroom without the proper requirements...a note will be sent home if your dancer is not in correct attire. NO SUMMER SHORTS, T-SHIRTS ETC...

BOYS – NO sweat pants please...Black jazz pants or semi-fitted shorts. (Not for Hip Hop, but Tap & Jazz)

In order to feel like a dancer you need to dress like one 😊

SOLO/DUO PRIVATE LESSONS:

Students interested in learning a solo/duo/trio for the competition season may pick up forms in the office or on the bulletin board.

Deadline to register is October 1st, so get forms in this week if you missed this 😊

Dancers may participate in 2 competitions as well as our Solo/Duo/Trio Recital on MARCH 7TH at the Regina Performing Arts Center. Costuming for these routines can be ordered from our suppliers (See your teacher and we will let you look through the books and price costumes out for you) or you may borrow/rent one from a previous dance year. Discuss your costume with your teacher as they need to approve it BEFORE stage.

*All students interested in participating are expected to practice outside of the allotted studio time and remember the choreography given to them by their teacher. This is a big commitment for both dancers and teachers so please talk directly to your teacher for more information!

(More specific information including the cost is on the Entry form for Solos/Duos/Trios.)

REMINDERS:

~DO NOT park on the north side of the studio in the driveway towards the alley. Teachers use the left side against the building for parking but it is against fire regulations to block the right side. Thank you.

~No peanut products allowed at the studio due to SEVERE allergies!

~ Class fees are due ON OR BEFORE the first of each month! **NO CHEQUES!**

~ Any accounts one-month overdue will be charged a 5% late fee on the first of the month!

~Please put all of your clothing shoes etc. into a dance bag and take into your dance room. (This will include jackets).

~ Please clean up after yourselves in the “kitchen” area of the studio!
(Make sure all garbage gets put into the garbage cans!)

~ Dancers & Parents: We ask that you please refrain from “loading up” on junk food (slurpees, straws full of sugar, etc.) between dance classes. Make healthy snack choices so you are not jumping off the walls in your classes on a sugar buzz! **NO POPCORN OR SLURPEES IN THE STUDIO!**

~ Please remember that regular attendance to classes is imperative! We tend to cover a lot of steps etc. each week and when a dancer misses often it is very difficult for them to catch up!

Please update any email/address changes in the office regularly...be sure we have your email for ALL newsletters! Read the studio bulletin boards for all dancer related information and expect a newsletter the first week of each month on the website

Dance Dimensions ~ Covid-19 Costume Sale

For 2019-2020 costumes only to re-use for this season

Drop Off

Saturday October 17th 6:30-8:30 PM @ the studio.

*Costume must be in a garment bag or large Ziplock. Labeled with the dancer's class from last season and their name. (Include phone number).

Sale

Sunday October 18th 10:00 AM – 1:00 PM @ the studio.

CASH only (as we are paying the person directly that day if a costume is sold!!)

Pick-up for any costumes that were NOT sold or to pick up your money from the sale if it WAS sold is also today from 3:00-5:00 PM. ***MUST BE PICKED UP TODAY as we cannot store them at the studio.**

How it works:

1. If your dancer has a costume that he/she has outgrown or is NOT using this season you are welcome to participate.
2. DD staff has set the price for ALL costumes so that each and every group is consistent. Remember that even though your dancer may not have used it, it is still a used costume. We are NOT keeping any of the money as a consignment company may do. This is being done to benefit our dancers and save families money by re-using last years costumes.

Tiny Tot, Combo & Pre-Primary Classes	\$50.00
Primary, Junior, Pre-Inter B, Inter B, Senior B Classes (Acro Also)	\$60.00
All Showstopper (As these are typically more expensive)	\$70.00

*If items are being sold separately this price will decrease for Troupe members.

3. Any dancer from last season can SELL a costume that they are not using or does not fit. Any dancer from this season can purchase one for this year's routines if they are available.

*This is keeping the costs down for all dance families and hopefully many dancers can utilize these costumes and we will not have to order many.

*In cases where the majority of a class does not fit, we WILL be simply ordering a new one for that group. This may pertain to our younger classes as those dancers are likely growing rapidly. This will be determined the first week of October as we are trying costuming on in class Saturday October 3rd – Thursday October 8th.
