*All credit cards on file will be charged for these. Prices will be charged to your accounts beginning November 3rd and emailed to you.

*For those that do not have a credit card on file, please pay your final costume payment during the office hours, or leave cash in the studio lockbox located outside the office.

All full season dancers require a costume this season, which is ordered. The charges on your account will reflect your \$75/class costume deposit. (As long as one was made).

The total costs for costuming are between \$80-\$120 for younger less competitive classes (Tiny Tot, Combo, Pre-Primary, Primary & Junior) and \$100-\$160 for older more competitive classes. (Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate & Senior levels).

Costumes for solos, duo & trios can be ordered from our costume catalogues also. These books will be available for you to look the week of NOV 1st – Nov. 8th. (Costumes for these must be turned into the office for pricing by Nov. 9th. Kara will price these out and email you the cost including US exchange, shipping etc.

Competition Information:

PLEASE READ!!

1. Invitational Dance Showcase Competition
Regina Performing Arts center
March 30th – April 3rd, 2022 (Wednesday – Sunday)

All studio classes compete at this competition with the EXCEPTION of our Tiny Tot & Combo classes.

2. Stars Of Tomorrow Competition
Regina Performing Arts Center
April 28th – May 1st, 2022 (Thursday – Sunday)

All studio classes compete at this competition with the EXCEPTION of our Tiny Tot, Combo, and Acrobatic classes.

NOTE: Disclaimer and very important information!!

Both of these events will be going forward in the spring. The one thing that we do not know for certain, is what the regulations from the City of Regina, as well as the SHA will be at that point.

Right now, all city buildings (including theatres) require a proof of vaccination or a negative covid test for people over age 12. We have NO WAY of knowing if this will remain in place or be changed by spring. We will continue to follow all government and SHA regulations.

Dance Studios and youth sports at this point are also not required to ask for proof of vaccination. Once again, we do not have control over this and if that changes, we will deal with that at that point.

Please note, that competition fees are all due by December 1st and they are non-refundable should a dancer choose not to take part by Spring. (Regardless of any government mandates put into place). ALL competition fees will be charged to your accounts mid-November and are due by Dec. 1st. The fees are as follows and each account will receive a statement of the fees owing. (This pertains to costume fees also, as they have to be ordered by mid-November and CANNOT be ordered at a later date).

Invitational Dance Showcase Fees:

Solo \$45/person
Duo/Trio \$35person
Group \$28/Person

Stars Of Tomorrow Competition Fees:

Solo \$38/person
Duo/Trio \$33person
Group \$28/Person

****All Solos/Duos will automatically be charged & entered for BOTH competitions unless the studio receives an email by NOVEMBER 27th stating that you do not wish to enter!!**

These fees are also due by December 1st for both competitions.

*ADD up your dancers group routines and this will give you a total of what is owing and will be charged to your accounts. (Add solo/duo/trios if applicable).

*Showstoppers – Will be notified about their extra competition when we have full details.

COMPETITION & COMPETITION FEES

Competition season will begin this year is the end of March/first week of April. This is a way for your child to have more opportunities to perform the routine they have worked on in class, other than the year-end recital. All of the dancers do their class routine on stage in competition with other dancers of the same age and level. Each dancer receives a ribbon for their performance as well as adjudication from the judge.

Our studio is a competition performance dance studio and all dancers are required to attend the competitions held in Regina. Please note that each group routine only performs once during the dance competition, and as soon as we have a schedule for you, we will post it on the website ~ usually one month before the event.
