### **DANCE INVASION COMPETITION (Important)**

Please note: Upon registration for the dance Invasion competition May  $1^{st}-4^{th}$  we were notified that there is a \$20/dancer charge for ALL dancers that will give you access to all your dancers phtos & vidoes. (Apparently this was in small print in the package, but to be honest we did not see that at all). This is mandatory and we therefore have to charge each dancer that fee. Only dancers attending the competition will be charged). These fees will be charged to your CC's on file as we process exam fees. (Between Monday Jan.  $6^{th}$  – Saturday Jan.  $11^{th}$ ).

## <u>COSTUMES/TIGHTS</u>

Costuming & Tights will be sent home with your dancer as they arrive. Tights/Curly hair pieces can still be ordered until January 14<sup>th</sup>! NOTE: They are not included in your costume charge.

If you do not order tights from us at the studio, see the Hair & Tights requirements newsletter on the website and you can get the tights your dancer needs at Dancers Den!

Please do not attempt to iron your costumes, as they may melt or deform. To release the wrinkles, steam only! (If the costume gets dirty from something hand wash and hang to dry, or dry-clean. -Certain costumes only).

\* If you did not order tights and are unsure of the hair requirements for your dancer's class, please see the bulletin board in the studio lobby or visit the website for each class requirement. Tights can also be purchased from the dancewear stores in Regina – Dancers Den or Suits & Soles.

\*Be sure that ALL leg lengths are appropriate and shortened if necessary.

### **\*\*PLEASE NOTE:**

All costumes are ordered to the measurements of your dancer, and are not custom sewn. Therefore, alterations are the responsibility of each person. If you wish to hire a seamstress to do them for you here is a list of available seamstresses, or check out a local shop such as Jean & Top on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave & Albert Street.
